

Virginia White Wines

Rappahannock Viognier \$36.00

This delicious 100% viognier wine is stainless steel fermented and aged in French oak barrels to reserve its fresh aromas of orange blossoms, lemon peel, cherry and peach.

Williamsburg Viognier 33.00

This wine has lovely hints of banana, orange, apple and lemongrass on both the nose and palate with a very rich, smooth and long finish with a touch of spiciness in its' personality.

Barboursville Sauvignon Blanc 28.00

This wine has hints of fresh citrus and light minerality, with herbal notes and traces of lush kiwi, all combined into a good body and pleasantly long finish.

Whitehall Pinot Gris 28.00

A fragrant bouquet of apples and pears precede a crisp palate filled with bright orange notes and a rich mineral finish.

Jefferson Pinot Gris 28.00

The nose on this varietal starts beautifully with lemon peel, star-anise, lychees, and apricot followed by green apple on the palate. This wine is very crisp with a balanced finish.

Horton Vineyards Black Cat 26.00

Chardonnay made from only the top oak barrels to be found. This wine is creamy and highly aromatic.

Gadino Cellars Chardonnay 34.00

A wine with finesse and beautiful structure and a lingering oak finish, with notes of lemon and vanilla. This wine is an excellent choice for shellfish, salmon and similar dishes.

Barboursville Rose 31.00

This wine shows extravagantly pretty stone fruit on both the nose and palate. On the palate the wine has hints of pineapple, strawberry and mango in a vivacious, pleasingly dry style with a soft finish.

Ox Eye Riesling 32.00

Grown in the Shenandoah Valley on a strong limestone base, this Virginia Riesling has notes of peaches, honey, and a hint of citrus with a flinty, bright acidity. This wine goes perfect with shellfish, pork and poultry.

Virginia Red Wines

Rappahannock Cellars Meritage \$36.00

Classic old World Bordeaux style blend is robust and rich without being too tannic. Distinguished by scents with the concentrated aromas of raspberries and cassis.

Horton Norton 28.00

Rich aromas of plums and cherries with a long pleasant spicy finish. Horton was the first vintner in Virginia to make Norton since prohibition.

Gabrielle Malbec 32.00

Somewhat inky in color, this malbec has spicy sweet aromas with plenty of black pepper and loads of black fruit.

Gadino Cabernet Franc 33.00

While the 2011 harvest weather disappointed many, this Cabernet Franc did not! It provides us with a medium body wine with a palate of blackberry fruit and pepper spice. European oak influenced the wine's structured tannins. Enjoy with hearty pasta dishes and other grilled favorites.

White Hall Merlot 29.00

Bouquets of dark cherries and cinnamon combine with deep royal colors to enhance flavors of dark chocolate and rich plums that precede a well-balanced finish of vanilla and oak.

Pollak Cabernet Franc 32.00

This wine has a bright ruby color with fragrances of pomegranate, cherry jam, and fresh cracked pepper. On the palate, soft impressions of blackberry and cassis with dark cocoa, and a velvety texture finish. Pairs well with beef, game, or vegetarian dishes.

King Family Merlot 44.00

Aged in French Barrels, note the richness of deep flavors such as dark cherry, strawberry and wet stone. A full mouth feel of mocha and spice with a long finish.

International Wines

Red

Cetamura Chianti – Italy \$6.00 Glass \$24.00 Bottle

Our house red. An easy-drinking blend of 90% Sangiovese and 10% Canaiolo from Chianti. Bright cherry and strawberry flavors with a zippy Sangiovese snap on the finish. Very enjoyable, the perfect summer red.

Altosur Malbec – Argentina 7.00 Glass 27.00 Bottle

A very subtle aroma is followed by flavors of berry and cherry with a hint of spice on the end. Very mellow, smooth and silky. This is a great example of the Malbec grape.

Pares Balta Petit Cabernet – Spain 8.00 Glass 30.00 Bottle

“Mas-Petit” is an elegant concentrated red composed of Cabernet and Garnacha. Inviting aromas of ripe raspberry and cherry are followed by a round fruit filled palate with smooth tannins and a balanced acidity.

White

Anna Lisa Pinot Grigio – Italy \$6.00 Glass \$22.00 Bottle

Our house white. Crisp, fresh and lively with a balanced fruit and acidity. An excellent wine to enjoy with lighter dishes and salads.

San De Guilhem Blanc – South France 7.00 Glass 22.00 Bottle

A lovely French summertime wine blended from Colombard, Gran Manseng and Ugni Blanc. A zesty white with a nose of white fruits and a clean fresh finish.

Novellum Chardonnay – France 8.00 Glass 30.00 Bottle

This outstanding 2012 Novellum competes with some of the finest Macon-Villages wines one can find. It is made from 100% Chardonnay. This crisp, fresh, medium-bodied Cotes-Catalenes exhibits lots of earthy characteristics with a salty sea breeze character.
